What is Marie-Kahle Comprehensive School Supporters' Association?

The Marie-Kahle Comprehensive School Supporters' Association primarily consists of parents whose children attend the school. Although it supports the school, it operates independently. Some of the school's needs that are not covered by the municipality or the state are financed by membership fees.

Membership, whether by parents or others, is voluntary and persists beyond a child's departure from the school unless cancelled. Parents may continue to be members of the Association after their children have left the school. Alternatively, they may cancel their membership (e.g. by sending an email to the Association).

The Association's committee, composed of parent volunteers, manages membership details, which remain confidential from the school. Membership status does not impact a child's academic performance.

An annual subscription fee of at least €12 is required. You must authorise automatic debit from your bank account.

The primary areas of support include:


- Funding school and leisure activities
- Supporting the integration of disabled or disadvantaged pupils
- Supplementing teaching and learning materials
- Providing resources aligned with the school's educational goals
- Facilitating working groups and community events to foster unity
- Grants for enhancing school facilities
- Assisting needy pupils in special circumstances, such as school trips
- Procuring educational materials

The Supporters' Association operates under a Managing Committee, elected by its members, who serve on a voluntary basis without compensation.

Members convene annually for a general meeting. Your email address is necessary for receiving invitations to this meeting, where you'll gain insight into how the Association's funds are allocated and participate in committee elections. In collaboration with the school management, the committee decides on the use of the funds. Recent initiatives funded by the Association include:

- Acquisition of tables and chairs for the learning centre
- Financial support for school excursions
- Funding for drug prevention programs
- Aid for students undertaking the Cambridge Language Certificate examination
